Instructions for printing the new one page, two sided, color brochure for the Statue of Responsibility Foundation:

- 1.** To maintain consistency, only use FedEx-Kinko's (now called FedEx-Office), the Foundation has a national discount in place with them and they have our tax exempt status on file so you won't pay sales tax (our IRS non-profit EIN number is 20-1435685). The account name is 'The Statue of Responsibility Foundation', the account number is #0446429825.
- 2.** Send this instructional PDF, that also contains both pages of the brochure, to Kinko's.
- 3.** Make sure they understand that the brochure is a two sided, front to back document, full color.
- 4.** Paper: 32 lb. Laser, stock # E-32.
- 5.** Brochure printed front to back.
- 6.** Do not scale or shrink to fit window.
- 7.** Print at 100% original size.
- 8.** Do not run through by-pass tray (this will eliminate paper curling).
- 9.** Best pricing comes with a minimum order of 500.
- 10.** Reminder: be sure to do a visual check of the first brochure before they print the entire order. Be sure that the back page is positioned correctly, front to back orientation.
- 11.** Note: Options to get the PDF file to Kinko's
 - a. Call your Kinko's store, get their email address, email them the instructional PDF (which contains both pages of the brochure).
 - b. Go to FedExOffice.com and find the 'print online' section, follow the instructions.
 - c. Call 1-800-2Kinkos and ask them for instructions using their 'Doc Store' procedure.
 - d. Copy the PDF on a disc and take the disc into your local Kinko's.
- 12.** Where is the PDF on the www.SORfoundation.org website? Go to 'Latest Updates' on the home page, look for the 'New Brochure' link.

We invite "Friends of Freedom" everywhere to come forth, to take a stand, to help build this "bookend" monument to Lady Liberty — the Statue of Responsibility!

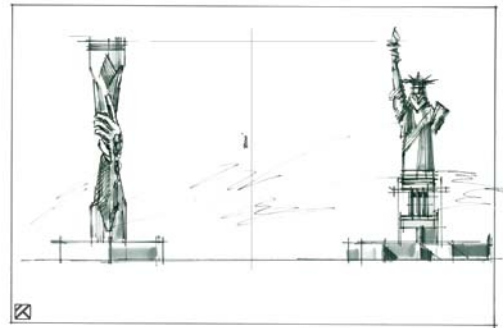

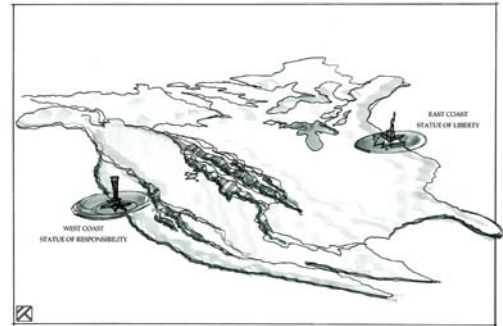

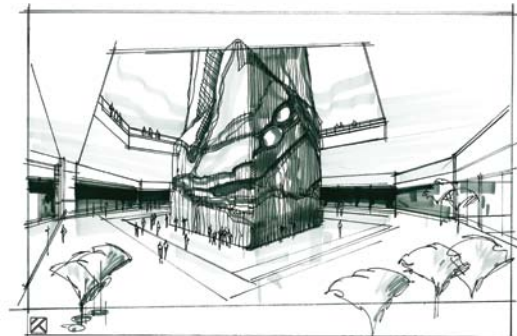
